Genesis 25:5 Abraham left everything he owned to Isaac.
God's command to sacrifice Isaac was to provide an example of absolute obedience. After God gave the command, "early the next morning Abraham got up and loaded his donkey" and headed out with his son and the wood for a burnt offering (Genesis 22:3). There was no delay, no questioning, no arguing.

Why did God command Abraham to sacrifice Isaac ...
The story of Abraham and Isaac is one of profound faith and obedience to God. When Abraham was 99 years old, God promised him and his wife Rebekah, then 89, a son. A year later God's promise came true when 99 year old Rebekah bore their son Isaac!

3 Abraham gave the name Isaac(a) to the son Sarah bore him. 4 When his son Isaac was eight days old, Abraham circumcised him, as God commanded him. 5 Abraham was a hundred years old when his son Isaac was born to him.

Genesis 21 NIV - The Birth of Isaac - Now the LORD was ...
Abraham passed the blessing on to Isaac as God had told Abraham (Genesis 17:15-17). The actual giving of the blessing (and the inheritance) was recorded in Genesis 25:5. God told Isaac and Rebekah to pass the blessing to their second born son, Jacob (Genesis 25:22-23).

How Was Isaac and Jacob Blessed?
Abraham answered, "My son, God will find Himself a lamb for the burnt offering." When they came to the place God had sent them to, Abraham built an altar and laid the wood on it. Then he tied Isaac and laid him on the wood, and Abraham lifted the knife to kill his son. But at that instant the angel of God shouted to him from Heaven, "Abraham!

At some point in Isaac's youth, his father Abraham took him to Mount Moriah. At God's command, Abraham was to build a sacrificial altar and sacrifice his son Isaac upon it. After he had bound his son to the altar and drawn his knife to kill him, at the very last moment an angel of God prevented Abraham from proceeding.

Isaac knew that God had promised to give him the land promised to his father Abraham (26:3-5). I believe he had finally come to see that through all the opposition over the wells he had dug, God had been guiding him back to the land of promise, back to those places where Abraham had walked in fellowship with God.

Abraham was 75 years old when he first received the promise, and Genesis 21:5 tells us he was 100 years old when Isaac was born. Sarah was 90. So Abraham and Sarah waited 25 years for the fulfillment of God's promise.

How long did Abraham and Sarah have to wait for Isaac ...
Abraham later marries Keturah and has six more sons; but, on his death, when he is buried beside Sarah, it is Isaac who receives "all Abraham's goods", while the other sons receive only "gifts" (Genesis 25:5-8).
