Johannes Brahms' Intermezzo in A Major, Op. 118, No. 2 pulls us into a world of dreamy nostalgia, quiet longing, and majestic, serene beauty. Intermezzo in A Minor op. 76 no. 7 was written in 1878 by Johannes Brahms. Brahms was a composer and pianist of the Romantic era of western art music. (You can read more about western art music in my article here.) He was born in Germany in 1833, and died in Vienna in 1897.

Brahms Intermezzo in A Major (Op. 118 No. 2)

The Brahms Intermezzi, Opus 117, No. 1,2,3 form a cycle of programmatic piano works. Brahms called these three intermezzi, "three lullabies to my sorrows." The first two intermezzi were inspired by the ancient english poem, "Lady Ann Bothwell's Lament " by Herder.

The three opening pieces of Opus 119 are titled "Intermezzo," Brahms's favored designation for a wide range of late piano pieces (see Opus 118 above). The first Intermezzo of Opus 119 is well-known for its characteristic falling thirds, which give it the resigned quality so often associated with Brahms's works.

Johannes Brahms The second piece is Intermezzo in A minor with a ternary form, marked Andante. It commences with a slightly sentimental and lingering quality. The music moves to a higher register as it enters the central section, which is marked Non troppo presto.

Works by difficulty: Johannes Brahms

In these pieces, Brahms was as generic as possible with his titles, wishing to avoid programmatic associations. Op. 76 contains four each of pieces labeled Capriccio and Intermezzo. The Capriccios are faster and more dramatic, generally looser in form, while the Intermezzi are more introspective and clear-cut.

Johannes Brahms (1833-1897) Let's finish the week with Johannes Brahms' Intermezzo in E major, No. 4 from the Seven Fantasies, Op. 116 for piano. Written in 1892 in the final years of Brahms' life, this is music infused with a deep sense of lonely introspection.

Each of the first three pieces is called an intermezzo, and the last a rhapsody (the German spelling Rhapsodie is also common in English publications). The fact that Brahms originally intended the title 'Capriccio' for his earlier Rhapsody, Op. 79, No. 1, suggests that he used such terms rather loosely.
